Background

The Maldivian Red Crescent (MRC) is an independent, voluntary, humanitarian organization established through the Maldivian Red Crescent Law (Law 7/2009). MRC's primary objective is to provide humanitarian aid and prevent and alleviate human suffering. Additionally, MRC'S Strategic Plan is centered around the concept of resilience. MRC's Strategic Plan 2019-2030 advocates for a shift in thinking and practice, recognizing the need for better coherence in the areas of disaster management, climate change, and development work. A key priority for MRC is working towards reducing vulnerabilities and increasing capacity to deal with frequently occurring natural hazards and the impact of natural disasters and climate change risks. This approach aims to increase the effectiveness of MRC's humanitarian role and work in Disaster Risk Management.

Maldivian Red Crescent (MRC) and Italian Red Cross (ITRC) have jointly established a Migrant Support Programme in the Maldives since 2019. This included the establishing of a Toll-free migrant support helpline which carried out referrals as well as vaccine registration during the COVID-19 pandemic. Furthermore, distribution of hygiene kits, carrying out of health and legal camps as well as capacity building activities including Basic First Aid trainings for migrants and the first ever Migration Practitioner Training of Trainers (ToT) in the South Asian Region was carried out with the technical and funding support of ItRC. In addition to the aforementioned activities, MRC also undertook a Migration and Displacement Needs Assessment with the support of ItRC as well. The Programme aligns with the IFRC Global Strategy on Migration 2018-2022 and the movement Migration Policy which stipulates that everyone across the movement jointly and individually addresses the humanitarian concerns of migrants throughout their journey. Additionally, the project is in line with the following purposes of provision of humanitarian aid and protection, upholding of migrants' rights and dignity, promotion of social inclusion.

MRC is currently working on the development of an outreach and awareness campaign focused on promoting the rights of migrants, with regards to healthcare, legal frameworks, migration safety, travel safety around health and Trafficking in Persons (TiP), and employer responsibilities.

- 3- Ensure consistency in design aesthetics, and formatting throughout the development process in alignment with MRC's Brand Guideline.
- 4- Provide printing and online publishing digital files for all materials developed
